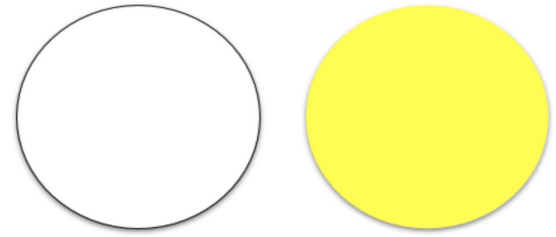

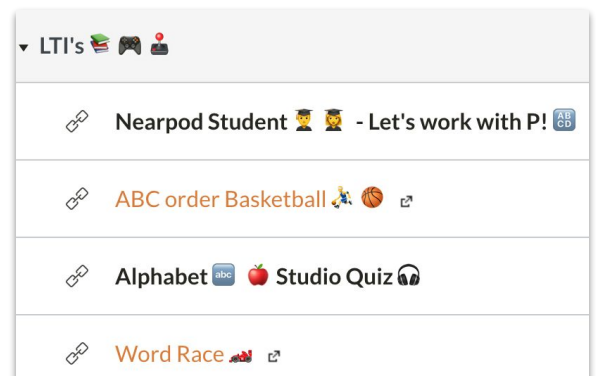



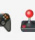
VOICE RECORDING
